

DECISION N°. 18220358 /MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC of 12 AOUT 2022

To launch the Competitive Entrance Examination into the first year of the Faculty of Engineering and Technology (FET) of the University of Buea for the 2022/2023 academic year.

Mindful of Decree n° 93/027 of 19th January 1993 fixing common dispositions in State Universities, modified and supplemented by Decree n°. 2005/342 of 10th September 2005;

Mindful of Decree N° 93/032 of 19th January 1993, fixing the financial regime applicable to Universities;
Mindful of Decree N° 2005/383 of 17th October 2005, fixing the financial rules applicable to Universities;
Mindful of Decree n° 2017/318 of 27th June 2017 appointing the Pro-Chancellor and Vice-Chancellor of the University of Buea;
Mindful of Decree n° 2012/578 of 4th December 2012 to appoint the Dean of the Faculty of Engineering and Technology;
Mindful of Order N° 18220053/MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC of 16th March 2022 fixing the calendar of competitive examinations into Establishments of Cameroon State Universities for the 2022/2023 academic year;
On the proposal of the Vice-Chancellor of the University of Buea;

DECIES:

Article 1: A Competitive Entrance Examination for the selection of **two hundred and seventy five (275)** students for admission into the first year of the Faculty of Engineering and Technology (FET) of the University of Buea will take place on the 8th September 2022, for the 2022/2023 academic year.

Article 2: The Competitive Entrance Examination shall be open to Cameroonians and foreigners of both sexes who fulfill one of the following sets of admission requirements:

a) *General Certificate of Education Ordinary Level in at least five subjects including Mathematics and Physics; and General Certificate of Education Advanced Level in at least two subjects which must include Mathematics.*

or

b) *General Certificate of Education Technical Ordinary and Advanced Levels in relevant subjects;*

or

c) *Baccalaureat C, D, F2; F3 and F4;*

or

d) *Technical and Vocational Education Examination (TVE) (Advanced Level)*

or

e) *Any other certificates recognized as equivalent by the Minister of Higher Education;*

Article 3: Candidates who have written one of the above mentioned certificate examinations (Article 2), but have not yet received their results, can register for the entrance examination. However, such candidates will be required to present their results to the Faculty of Engineering and Technology, if they are successful in the entrance examination, before they can be admitted into the Faculty.

Article 4: The allocation of available places to the programmes of the Faculty of Engineering and Technology is as follows:

Article 5: Application Procedure: Candidates are required to apply online at the University of Buea website www.ubuea.cm. The online application will only be validated after payment of an examination fee of **CFAF 20,000** (twenty thousand francs) in the following account:

Article 6: The examination will take place in four centres which include Buea, Bamenda, Douala and Yaounde.

Article 7: The closing date for online application is **7th September 2022**.

Article 8: The written examination shall consist of the following papers:

Papers	Coefficients	Duration
Mathematics	3	3 Hours
Physics	3	3 Hours

Article 9: The venues of the various centres and the examination schedule will be specified subsequently by a press release made by the Vice-Chancellor of the University of Buea.

Article 10: Candidates are required to be at the examination centre at least one hour before the beginning of the first paper. They are requested to come along with their National Identity Cards.

Article 11: The Vice-Chancellor of the University of Buea, the Director of University Accreditation and Quality and the Dean of the Faculty of Engineering and Technology of the University of Buea shall be responsible, each in his/her own sphere, for the implementation of this decision which shall be registered and published wherever necessary.
